

Accident Scene Management Course Discussion:

MANAGE THE SCENE

1. Designate Who is in Charge

Call, or send someone to call, 911

Look for possible ejected passengers up to 150 feet away

Move uninvolved vehicles

Leave 100 foot area open for emergency vehicles

2. Make Yourself Visible

Reflective vest & light

Remove YOUR helmet

3. Control Traffic

4. DO NOT DISTURB EVIDENCE!

Take photos & video before moving ANYTHING

Protect Patient Privacy

Get Witness Info: name & contact info

5. Triage

Green: involved but ok – get medically checked

Yellow: needs treatment but not life-threatening

Red: needs life saving treatment

6. Moving the Injured

ONLY if leaving in place risks further injury

Let injured move self if possible

Know WHY movement was necessary

ROLL onto space blanket by shoulder & pelvis (helps to slide injured)

Move on back in HEAD FIRST direction, if possible

Put injured in “puke & drool” recovery position, not on back
