

WITW National Parks Patch Rules

This is from STB 190 p.3 where it was first announced.

"WITW National Parks Patch – A new ride event; collect fifteen (15) National Parks stamps on the form provided and receive a WITW National Parks Patch.

Our National Parks seem to be a popular destination for our members. Many already have the NP Passports and stamp them with the little rubber stamp that has the location and the date. And, did you know that there are 417 National Parks in the US and more than 48 in Canada (free this anniversary year [2017]), 15 in the UK and several in Portugal. The rubber stamp & ink pad can be found at the Visitors Center. So start riding to the Parks (Seashores, Monuments, Forests and Historic Sites) and collect your first fifteen. The patch will have additional stars to color in as you achieve the milestones of 25, 35, 50 and 75 parks visited." [There is also a 100 pin that fits into the patch.] "Includes National Parks, Monuments, Seashores, Historical Sites, Historical Trails, Forests, Battlefields, Lakeshores, Preserves, etc. – wherever you can get a stamp." (from the revised form from 6-13-17)

Additional info from answered questions:

The requirements for this patch are cumulative and not constrained to a single year

Any NPS stamp only counts once, even if the same park is visited on multiple occasions.
